City officials recommend that the City Council of the City of Toronto pass a By-law to increase current Solid Waste Rates and Fees, and to introduce new Solid Waste Rates and Fees, all effective January 1, 2017, as indicated below.

1. Key Solid Waste Rates and Fees proposed to increase by 5.2%

As stated in the Budget Committee Public Notice, City officials are recommending a 5.2% increase to the current Solid Waste Rates and Fees set forth in Schedule 1 of Appendix A to Chapter 441 of the Toronto Municipal Code (the "Schedule"). Below are examples of several key Solid Waste Rates and Fees from the Schedule with the 5.2% increase applied.

Please note that the remaining rates and fees found on the Schedule but not listed below also have been recommended to increase by 5.2%, otherwise indicated in the Appendix.
