SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to recommend Council Member appointments to the Etobicoke York Community Preservation Panel.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council consider Members' preferences listed in Attachment 1 and recommend to Council the appointment of one to three Members to the Etobicoke York Community Preservation Panel for a term of office until November 30, 2018, and until their successors are appointed.

DECISION HISTORY

City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 103, Heritage, sets out the composition and nomination process for the City's Community Preservation Panels. The Etobicoke York Community Council is to nominate one to three Members of Council for appointment to the Community Preservation Panel for the Community Council area.

Council appointed Members in February 2015 for a term of office ending December 31, 2016 and until successors are appointed. It is now necessary to appoint Members for the second half of the Council term.
