Subject: Designation of Significant Event for the Lakeshore Village Grilled Cheese Competition– June 11th, 2016 – Ward 6, Etobicoke – Lakeshore

I would like to present the following Motion to Etobicoke York Community Council:

SUMMARY:

The inaugural Lakeshore Grilled Cheese Challenge will take place on Lake Shore Blvd West from Eighth Street to Sixth Street and will involve the closure of (1) eastbound lane and the curb lane and all side streets South of Lake Shore Blvd. in the closure area to the nearest laneway with the exemption on Seventh Street which will be closed to 118 Seventh Street. The closure will occur from 6:00 a.m. on Saturday June 11th to 9:00 p.m. on Saturday June 11th. One (1) eastbound lane and all west bound lanes will remain unobstructed. The hours of operation will be from 11:090 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Saturday June 11th.

On behalf of the Committee, organizers and participants, the Lakeshore Grilled Cheese Challenge seeks, a Special Occasion Permit under the Community Festival section of the Ontario Liquor Licence Act:

According to Section 40 of the Regulations of the Ontario Liquor Licence Act, an application for a Special Occasion Permit for a community festival must be approved by the local Council for the Municipality in which the event is to occur.

RECOMMENDATION:

1. Etobicoke York Community Council deems the inaugural Lakeshore Grilled Cheese Challenge to be an event of municipal and/or community significance, and to advise the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario that it has no objection to this event.
