### Review of Proposed Noise By-law

#### Committee Decision

The Toronto Music Industry Advisory Council recommends that the Licensing and Standards Committee:

1. Request the General Manager, Municipal Licensing and Standards to work with the Toronto Music Industry Advisory Council and the General Manager, Economic Development and Culture to develop a communications strategy, on the new Noise By-law, when adopted, for music industry stakeholders that includes:

- a summary of the new noise by-law;
- information on how violations will be treated;
- details on how enforcement will be carried out; and,
- an explanation of the increased fines for violation of the by-law.

The Toronto Music Industry Advisory Council:

1. Requested its Chair, and Co-Chair, to review the proposed by-law upon its release, and submit further comments to the Licensing and Standards Committee, if necessary.
