Re.: LS11.2 – Chapter 591, Noise - Amendments after further consultation

Dear Members of the Municipal Licensing and Standards Committee,

I am writing on behalf of GYRA, the Greater Yorkville Residents Association, representing the interests of over 5,000 owners and residents living in 34 condominium buildings within an area bounded by Yonge, Charles, Avenue Rd. and Davenport.

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that GYRA participated in and are fully supportive of the Toronto Noise Coalition recommendations.

Of particular concern to our residents are the issues of;

-excessive patio noise, especially after 11 pm,

-constant loud motorcycle noise at all hours of the evening and into the early morning hours

-additional enforcement required

We strongly feel that this new draft noise bylaw does not adequately address these concerns and we urge the committee to send this back to staff for additional work and consultation with Toronto residents.
