The Bayview Village Association (BVA) Supports the FoNTRA 7 point action plan and ask that this letter be included in the May 19 Agenda.

Of particular concern to Bayview Village are:

- 1. Relaxation of construction noise by law (contractors building infill housing pay no attention to suppressing noise)
- 2. Lack of enforcement on weekends (today) especially Sunday, again many contractors operate heavy equipment and machinery on Sundays and know they can get away with it
- 3.
