We support the recommendation in background file 96029, Chapter 591, Noise Bylaw Review: Working Group and Noise Monitoring Study, prepared by the executive director of Municipal Licensing and Standards that the "Licensing and Standards Committee refer the noise review to the Executive Director, Municipal Licensing and Standards, to convene the Noise Working Group and report back with proposed amendments to Chapter 591, Noise after the Noise Working Group has completed its review and Toronto Public Health has completed its noise monitoring Study."
