Proposed Official Plan Amendment Pertaining to Greenbelt Plan Conformity

PROPOSAL – PURPOSE AND EFFECT

The City of Toronto is currently undertaking a review of the Official Plan which was adopted by Council in 2002 and came into effect in 2006. A copy of the current Official Plan can be viewed or downloaded from the City's website: www.toronto.ca/planning/official_plan/.

The Planning Act requires that an Official Plan be reviewed at least every 5 years. The holding of public hearings on the Official Plan Review may be delegated by Council to Planning and Growth Management Committee under Section 24 of the City of Toronto Act and the Toronto Municipal Code.

The Official Plan is proposed to be amended to conform to the Greenbelt Plan (2005) and various environmental planning initiatives by:

- amending Chapter 2 to identify the Greenbelt Protected Countryside and recognize Greenbelt River Valley Connections;
- amending Site and Areas Specific Policies (SASP) 135 and 141 to reflect Greenbelt Plan requirements, including amending the area subject to the policies and providing more detailed direction on how natural and hydrologic features and functions should be protected; and
- amending SASP 141 to reflect key policy goals of the 1994 Rouge Park Plan, including protecting the area within 30 meters of the stable top of bank, and to identify how the City will work with Parks Canada on the Rouge National Urban Park.

FURTHER INFORMATION

If you wish to be notified of the adoption or refusal of the proposed Official Plan Amendment, you must make a written request to the City Clerk, attention: Nancy Martins, Administrator, Planning and Growth Management Committee at the address, fax number or e-mail set out in this notice.

Official Plan Amendment Appeal: If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk, attention: Nancy Martins, Administrator, Planning and Growth Management Committee at the address, fax number or e-mail set out in this notice, before the Council decision on the proposed Official Plan Amendment, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board and may

not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

People writing or making presentations at the public meeting: The *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the *Planning Act*, and the City of Toronto Municipal Code authorize the City of Toronto to collect any personal information in your communication or presentation to City Council or its committees.

The City collects this information to enable it to make informed decisions on the relevant issue(s). If you are submitting letters, faxes, e-mails, presentations or other communications to the City, you should be aware that your name and the fact that you communicated with the City will become part of the public record and will appear on the City's website. The City will also make your communication and any personal information in it - such as your postal address, telephone number or e-mail address - available to the public, unless you expressly request the City to remove it.

The City videotapes committee and community council meetings. If you make a presentation to a committee or community council, the City will be videotaping you and City staff may make the video tapes available to the public.
