Amendment to Chapter 441, Planning Application Review Fees including new fees and changes to existing fees

The Council of the City of Toronto will be considering a recommendation to adopt new planning application fees and changes to existing planning application fee amounts, and to amend the City of Toronto Municipal Code, Schedule 13 of Chapter 441, Fees and Charges to reflect these new and changed fees. A listing of the proposed changes to existing planning application fees and the proposed new planning application fees is contained in Appendix 1 to the report (October 13, 2016) from the Chief Planner, and Executive Director, City Planning (**EX18.14**).

At its meeting to be held in Committee Room 1 in Toronto City Hall on October 26th, 2016, at 9:30 a.m., or as soon as possible thereafter, the Executive Committee of Toronto City Council will hear in person or by his or her counsel, agent or solicitor, any person who wishes to speak to the matter.

The Executive Committee will forward its recommendations for City Council's consideration at its meeting on November 8 and 9, 2016. Any adopted fees will be implemented through a by-law that will amend the Municipal Code.

While the report recommends a proposed new fee schedule, the Executive Committee may change this recommendation. Further, Toronto City Council may adopt a fee schedule that differs from the recommendation, including those that are higher or lower than the fees set out in the report.
