Dear Members of the Planning and Growth Management Committee,

Please be advised that Metrolinx has purchased the Canpa Subdivision, including 33 Wickman Road, from Canadian Pacific Railway effective November 27, 2015. Metrolinx has a responsibility to develop sources of secondary land-use revenue to assist with its significant capital funding requirements and growing real estate expenses. To that end, Metrolinx wishes to continue with the application to modernize the existing signboard at 33 Wickman Road.

My understanding is similar Metrolinx applications, whereby a number of static signboards are removed in exchange for permission to modernize another, have received favourable consideration. I would ask that this 33 Wickman Road application also receive your thoughtful consideration.
