Of Bill 151: Waste-Free Ontario Act**

Year	Implementation Action
2016	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empower the Authority to carry out compliance, enforcement and data collection and develop first policy statement. • Begin designating new materials for diversion (e.g. additional electronics, carpet and batteries). • Begin transition of diversion programs, completion time may vary by program (i.e. Blue Bin recycling transition may take over five years). • Begin development of Organics Action Plan. • Review and begin implementation under 3Rs Regulation under the Environmental Protection Act.
2017	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consult on first disposal bans for first set of materials, including Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment and compact fluorescent light bulbs.
2018	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Begin implementation of organics plan and updated 3Rs Regulation.
2019	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Consider more disposal bans and designating additional materials under Extended Producer Responsibility including Institutional, Commercial & Industrial printed paper and packaging.
2020	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • First Ministry review of Bill 151: Waste-Free Ontario Act
