At its meeting on Thursday, February 25, 2016 the Toronto Transit Commission Board considered the attached report entitled "TTC Bicycle Initiatives".

The Board approved the recommendation in the staff report, as follows:

- i) That the Board request staff to establish a dedicated bike plan staff and team.

- iv) That the Board request staff to review the feasibility of introducing semi-permanent (e.g. metal) stair channels at existing stations; and
- v) Where feasible, install semi-permanent stair channels as a specific initiative within the TTC's Bike Plan.
