RE: Agenda Item Addition – 1145 Ossington Ave, TCS relocation

DATE: January 21st, 2016

Recommendation:

City Council approve the relocation of the traffic control signals at Ossington Avenue and a point 54 metres north of Acores Avenue, to Ossington Avenue and a point 90 metres north of Acores Avenue (drawing attached).

Discussion:

The rationale for this change is to accommodate an access road for a new residential development on the east side of Ossington Avenue at No. 1145. As the present location of the access road will conflict with the existing mid-block traffic control signals, it will be necessary to relocate the signals to a new location, about 40 metres to the north.

This motion has the concurrence of the respective Councillors on both sides of Ossington Avenue.

The costs of the relocation will be fully borne by the developer at 1145 Ossington Avenue.
