#### 1145 Ossington Avenue - Traffic Control Signal Relocation

##### Committee Decision

The Public Works and Infrastructure Committee:

1. Deferred consideration of the item pending community consultation, further consultation with the affected Ward Councillors, and report from the General Manager, Transportation Services.

##### Origin

(January 21, 2016) Letter from Councillor Joe Mihevc

##### Summary

The rationale for this change is to accommodate an access road for a new residential development on the east side of Ossington Avenue at No. 1145. As the present location of the access road will conflict with the existing mid-block traffic control signals, it will be necessary to relocate the signals to a new location, about 40 metres to the north.

This motion has the concurrence of the respective Councillors on both sides of Ossington Avenue.

The costs of the relocation will be fully borne by the developer at 1145 Ossington Avenue.
