RE: Agenda Item PW12.3, Bike Parking at Subway Stations

**DATE:** April 20, 2016

## Recommendation:

That the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee request the City Transportation Department's Bicycling unit work with the TTC to develop a bike parking strategy at subway stations, and report back in conjunction with the TTC on the plan by the end of 2016 in preparation for the 2017 budget process.

## Comments:

- The areas around subway stations are a mess with bikes attached to various supports including sign posts, hydrants, fences, trees, benches, etc, other than proper bike parking infrastructure.
- The land around subway stations are owned, some by the TTC and some by the city. This requires both parties to work out a plan.
- An integrated approach is needed to maximize bike parking and address the demand.
