RE: LETTER OF SUPPORT – DANFORTH MAJOR CORRIDOR STUDY


Dear Public Works and Infrastructure Committee

I am writing to you on behalf of the Danforth Mosaic BIA Board of Directors to express our enthusiasm and support for the Danforth Avenue Major Corridor Study - agenda item PW13.11: Ten Year Cycling Corridor Study. Stretched across a 3km stretch of busy corridor, the Danforth Mosaic BIA recognizes both the positive and negative impacts of traffic flow, and we are keen to take any opportunity to improve the livability of our neighbourhood as a means of increasing access to and the safety of local business.

Following the lead of Councillor Paula Fletcher, we request that the study take place in 2017, so that it coincides with the Avenue Study already scheduled to take place along Danforth Avenue.
