George Keddy was born in 1923 and served in World War II as a paratrooper. As part of D-Day, George jumped out of a plane one minute after midnight on June 5, 1944. George was wounded later in the war, and was also captured and was a prisoner of war for almost two years.

George worked as a Foreman at Toronto Hydro – working on projects like the CN Tower and the Skydome - until his retirement.

As a proud Canadian Legion Member, George marched with pride and served as Honour Guard to Mayor David Miller.
