Born in Coatbridge, Scotland, Mary immigrated to Canada and settled in Toronto where she raised her two sons. She founded Mary Macleod's Shortbread in 1981 and eventually moved her bakery to the Riverside area on Queen Street East, where it continues to flourish.

Mary's signature shortbread was an instant hit and three decades later it's still a Toronto, and now, international favourite. A true original, hers was the first business in Canada devoted exclusively to making artisanal shortbread.

In the course of her years, Mary Macleod touch the lives and palates of many people. Her generosity of spirit and thoughtfulness touched many lives and leaves a lasting legacy.
