The Mayor and Members of Toronto City Council are deeply saddened to learn of the bombing of St. Mark's Cathedral during Sunday morning mass on December 11, 2016 in Cairo, Egypt.

The bomb was placed in the chapel, a section of the St. Mark's Cathedral, which was reserved for women and children. Twenty-five people lost their lives and a further forty-nine people have been wounded. St. Mark's Cathedral is the seat of Egypt's Coptic Orthodox Christian Church.

The City Clerk is requested to convey, on behalf of the Members of Toronto City Council, our sincere sympathy to the families of the victims and to the Coptic Community in Toronto.
