SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends that a minor street stop sign be deployed at the intersection of Amiens Road at Fairwood Crescent, which is currently an uncontrolled three-way "T-type" intersection, in order to clearly define the right-of-way and to regulate traffic flow.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Transportation Services recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Authorize stop control for Amiens Road at the intersection of Fairwood Crescent.

Financial Impact

The financial cost of installing the subject recommended stop control is approximately \$400.00. The funding for this sign is available in the Transportation Services 2016 Operating Budget, within Cost Centre TP0397.

ISSUE BACKGROUND

During an operational review, Transportation Services staff identified a three-way intersection with no stop sign at Amiens Road and Fairwood Crescent.

COMMENTS

The following characteristics describe the intersection of Amiens Road and Fairwood Crescent:

- This uncontrolled intersection is located north of Kingston Road, east of Morningside Avenue, and west of Military Trail.
- There are no sidewalks located at the intersection of Amiens Road and Fairwood Crescent.
- Both Amiens Road and Fairwood Crescent have posted 40 km/h speed limits.
- The land use in this area is primarily single family residential.

A minor street stop sign is recommended at the uncontrolled three-way "T-type" intersection on northbound Amiens Road at Fairwood Crescent to clearly define the right-of-way for motorists. The stop sign will also provide stop sign uniformity in the area and enhance driver and pedestrian safety.
