**Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments Appeal:** If a person or public body does not make oral submissions at a public meeting or make written submissions to the City Clerk, attention: Yvonne Davies, Administrator, Scarborough Community Council, at the address, fax number or e-mail set out in this notice before the proposed Official Plan Amendment is adopted or refused and/or Zoning By-law Amendments are passed or refused, the person or public body is not entitled to appeal the decision to the Ontario Municipal Board and may not be added as a party to the hearing of an appeal before the Ontario Municipal Board unless, in the opinion of the Board, there are reasonable grounds to do so.

**People writing or making presentations at the public meeting:** The *City of Toronto Act, 2006*, the *Planning Act*, and the City of Toronto Municipal Code authorize the City of Toronto to collect any personal information in your communication or presentation to City Council or its committees.
