## **Compulsory Stop Controls - Lakeland Crescent Area**

**To:** Scarborough Community Council

#### **SUMMARY**

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

This report recommends that minor street stop signs be installed at two uncontrolled three-way intersections in the Lakeland Crescent area in order to clearly define the right-of-way and to regulate traffic flow.

#### RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District recommends that:

- 1. Scarborough Community Council authorize compulsory stop control for eastbound traffic on Lakeland Crescent at Mid Pines Road.
- 2. Scarborough Community Council authorize compulsory stop control for westbound traffic on Point Grey Crescent at Linville Road.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the recommended stop signs is approximately \$1,000.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2016 Operating Budget, within Cost Centre TP0397.

#### **DECISION HISTORY**

This report addresses a new initiative.

#### **COMMENTS**

As a result of a public request via 3-1-1, Transportation Services staff reviewed the traffic controls in the Lakeland Crescent area and identified two uncontrolled three-way intersections. The uncontrolled intersections are Lakeland Crescent at Mid Pines Road, and Point Grey Crescent at Linville Road.

The following characteristics describe the two uncontrolled three-way intersections:

- The uncontrolled intersections are located south of Brimorton Drive, and east of Scarborough Golf Club Road.
- Sidewalks are located on at least one side of the road at both locations.
- The land use in this area is single family residential dwellings.

Minor street stop signs are recommended at the two uncontrolled three-way "T-type" intersections which will provide stop sign uniformity on the streets in this area, clearly define the right-of-way, and enhance driver and pedestrian safety.
