

# **Stopping Prohibitions – Scarborough Golf Club Road**

#### SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which the Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

The report recommends the installation of a "No Stopping Anytime" regulation on both sides of Scarborough Golf Club Road, near Gatesview Avenue. Currently, a Pedestrian Crossover is located on Scarborough Golf Club Road just south of Gatesview Avenue, with stopping regulations in effect within 9 metres of this device.

## RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Transportation Services, Scarborough District recommends that:

1. Scarborough Community Council prohibit stopping at all times on the east side of Scarborough Golf Club Road, between a point 160 metres north of Kingston Road and a point 96 metres further north, and on the west side of Scarborough Golf Club Road between a point 30 metres south of Gatesview Avenue and a point 22 metres north of Gatesview Avenue.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT

The financial cost of installing the No Stopping Anytime signs on Scarborough Golf Club Road is approximately \$2,000.00. The funding for these signs is available in the Transportation Services Division's 2016 Operating Budget, within Cost Centre TP0397.

# **DECISION HISTORY**

This report addresses a new initiative.

# COMMENTS

As a result of a public request via 3-1-1, Transportation Services staff reviewed this roadway to determine if more stringent parking regulations are justified.

The following characteristics describe Scarborough Golf Club Road and Gatesview Avenue:

- Scarborough Golf Club Road is a north-south minor arterial road, with recorded 24-hour vehicle volumes that fall within the typical values for this roadway classification.
- A Pedestrian Crossover is located on Scarborough Golf Club Road north of Kingston Road at Gatesview Avenue (on the south leg).
- Vehicles parking on either side of the road increase congestion and reduce motorist ability to view pedestrians crossing at the Pedestrian Crossover.
- The land uses on this roadway is mixed. Commercial, single family homes, along with street town homes are all located on this section of Scarborough Golf Club Road.
- The current posted regulation prohibits stopping within 9 metres of the pedestrian crossover.

In order to extend motorists sight lines of pedestrians crossing at the Pedestrian Crossover, the No Stopping Anytime regulation which exists only within 9 metres of this device is recommended to be extended on both sides of the subject area on Scarborough Golf Club Road. This type of regulation prohibits the halting of a vehicle, even momentarily, whether occupied or not. This will improve safety for pedestrians and motorists on this section of roadway.
