SUMMARY

The purpose of this report is to fill an upcoming vacancy on the Board of Health resulting from the resignation of Councillor Jon Burnside from the Board.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The City Clerk recommends that:

1. Striking Committee consider Members' preferences and recommend to City Council the appointment of one Council Member to the Board of Health for a term starting August 1, 2016 and ending December 31, 2016 and until a successor is appointed.
