DIRECT INVESTMENTS

Investment Type	Approx. Investment	Purpose & Impact
Green Condo Loans (4)	\$2.5M	Bridge first/second cost challenge, allowing developers to build better-than-Code efficiency
ESPAs (6)	\$4.4M	Address market barriers with non- debt financing, backstopped by insurance. Also, warehousing for ECC.
Efficiency Capital Corp.	Up to \$2M	Retrofit transaction financing to achieve scale.
Various other loans Toronto Atmospheric	\$2M Fund	Advance solar technologies, geothermal, etc.
