

## **Request received to impose operating conditions to a boulevard café permit located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106**

### **SUMMARY**

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This staff report is about a matter for which the Toronto and East York Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision.

To report on the request received from the Ward Councillor to impose operating conditions for the boulevard cafe permit located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

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The Director of Business Licensing and Regulatory Services, Municipal Licensing & Standards recommends that:

1. The application for the proposed boulevard café permit located 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106 be approved.
2. The operating conditions proposed by the Ward Councillor for the proposed boulevard café permit located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106 be considered:
  - a. Approve the application for the proposed boulevard café permit located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106 for a one year term expiring on August 15, 2017.
  - b. The outdoor patio be closed for operations no later than 11:00 pm on any night of the week.
  - c. That no amplified noise be allowed on the patio.

- d. The operator must ensure the patio and furniture is maintained in a state of good repair.
- e. The operator must ensure the patio is swept daily.

## **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

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There are no financial implications resulting from the adoption of this report.

## **DECISION HISTORY**

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An application for a boulevard café permit located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106 was received on July 27, 2016 from the business owner representing Adam Food Corp., operating as Barburrito Yonge South.

The application submitted was seeking permission to establish a boulevard café located at 419 Yonge Street, Unit 106 for 28.1 square metres which would accommodate approximately 22 patrons. (Appendix No. 1)

A request from the Ward Councillor was received on August 11, 2016 for the matter to be brought forward to the Toronto and East York Community Council to impose operating conditions and change the permitted operating hours on the boulevard café permit application.

## **COMMENTS**

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This application meets the physical criteria for a boulevard café, as set out in Chapter 313, Section 313-36 of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code.
