Dear Chair Councillor Layton and Members of the Toronto and East York Community Council:

Re: Registered Nurses Association of Ontario
158 Pearl Street (Ward 20)
Item No. TE14.9 on the Tuesday, February 23, 2016 Agenda
City of Toronto's Heritage Register

We are the solicitors acting on behalf of the Registered Nurses Association of Ontario ("RNAO"). The RNAO has over 40,000 nurse members and is the owner of the property municipally known as 158 Pearl Street in the City of Toronto. The RNAO contacted me on the evening of Thursday, February 18, 2016 regarding information they recently indirectly received with respect to a report recommending inclusion of their property on the City of Toronto's Heritage Register that is scheduled to be considered by the TEYCC on Tuesday, February 23, 2016 at 10:00 am. The RNAO informed me that they had not received Notice of either the said report, nor of the scheduling of this item on the TEYCC's agenda.

On behalf of the RNAO I am requesting that this item be deferred to a subsequent meeting of the TEYCC in order to permit the RNAO and myself to obtain any and all relevant information related to this item prior to consideration by the TEYCC. We respectfully submit that given the importance and potential impacts of the inclusion of the property on the City of Toronto's Heritage Register it is critical that our client is afforded sufficient time to fully review this matter and make, if necessary, any informed submissions by the TEYCC prior to consideration.

Currently I have a scheduling conflict on Tuesday morning and I am uncertain if I will be able to reorganize my calendar to attend the TEYCC. I would ask you to list me as a deputation on this item and if I am unable to rearrange my schedule I will ensure that someone from my office is able to attend to speak to the adjournment request.

We thank the Committee Members for their consideration of our request on behalf of the RNAO and its 40,000 members.
