Re: Request for Event of Municipal Significance

The tenth annual Roncesvalles Polish Festival will be taking place on September 17 and 18, 2016. We are anticipating between 300,000 and 350,000 in attendance over the weekend.

The Roncesvalles Polish Festival, as usual, takes place on Roncesvalles Avenue from just north of Queen up to Dundas Street West. As in previous years, this does involve a road closure of Roncesvalles Avenue. In 2016 we have applied for a road closure on Roncesvalles Avenue from 5:00 a.m. on Saturday September 17 to 11:00 pm. on Sunday, September 18. On the evening of Friday September 16, we may also hold a Polka Party at the St-Casimir Church Hall from 8pm to 2am and a VIP reception at Prints Charming (388 Roncesvalles Avenue) from 5:00 pm to 7:00 p.m.

By this letter, we are requesting that the City of Toronto declare the 2016 Roncesvalles Polish Festival to be an event of Municipal Significance.
