RE: Event of Municipal Significance - The Village Festival

The Church Wellesley Village Business Improvement Area is in the process of planning for a special street closure as an affiliate event of Pride 2016 festivities.

The event will require street closure from Saturday, June 25, 2016 at 9am through Monday, June 27, 2016 at 2am. Extended food and beverage patio service will adhere to the following schedule:

Saturday, June 25th, 2016 11:00am – 12:00am (midnight)

Sunday, June 26th, 2016 11:00am – 12:00am (midnight)

**Last call for alcohol service on the extended patios will be 11:00pm.*

Programmed as a neighbourhood "block party," there will be a single stage located at the northwest corner of Church Street and Maitland Street, where entertainers booked for this event will perform. There will be no use of public nudity during any of these performances.

The street closure will extend from the south side of Wood Street at Church Street, to the south side of Gloucester Street at Church Street. In addition, approximately 100 feet of Wood Street, east of Church Street, 100 feet of Maitland Street, both east and west of Church Street, and 100 feet of Alexander Street, both east and west of Church Street, will be included in the street closure perimeter. As well, approximately 100 feet of Dundonald Street west of Church Street and all of Monteith Street will also be part of this closure. Vehicle access to Monteith Street or Dundonald Street will be escorted by a paid duty police or security officer to and from Gloucester Street. Vehicles exiting from Dundonald Street and Monteith Street will be escorted north on Church Street to Gloucester Street.

On behalf of several Licensed Bars and Restaurants within The Village BIA's boundaries, the BIA is submitting applications to the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario.

This AGCO request is with respect to a temporary extension of approximately 5 feet on to the public roadway on Church Street and similar temporary extension on Maitland, Alexander, and Wood Streets.
