SUMMARY

At its meeting of January 18, 2017, the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee directed the General Manager, Solid Waste Management Services, to submit a supplementary report directly to City Council indicating the number of employees who are employed by the City for the purposes of collecting residential solid waste in District 4 that could be impacted by a contracting out decision.
