DECISION HISTORY

At the Public Works & Infrastructure Committee (PWIC) Meeting on January 18, 2017, Committee Chair, Councillor Jaye Robinson tabled the following motion with respect to item PW18.3:

"That the General Manager, Solid Waste Management Services, submit a supplementary report directly to City Council that indicates the number of employees who are employed by the City and who provide the service that is the subject of this report, being the collection of residential waste in District 4."

COMMENTS

Legal counsel for TCEU, Local 416 - CUPE has asserted, in correspondence to the City Solicitor, that the City should delay any decision in relation to the above-noted Report, pending the outcome of a review of the actions of the Chair. The Union asserts that the identification of the number of TCEU, Local 416 - CUPE staff assigned to the collection of residential waste in District 4 may have compromised the process recommended in the above noted Report.

At the meeting of the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee held January 18, 2017, the Committee directed the General Manager, Solid Waste Management Services, to submit a supplementary report directly to City Council identifying this staffing number. The General Manager has submitted a Supplementary Report to Council, providing this information.

On January 20, 2017, a response was provided to legal counsel for TCEU, Local 416 - CUPE. The response is attached.
