Dear Ms. Watkiss.

The Downtown Yonge Business Improvement Area (DYBIA) works as a tireless advocate for the well-being of our neighbourhood. We believe that collaboration, stewardship and facilitation are key roles that the DYBIA can play in achieving a healthy, prosperous and growing district economy.

Today, for that reason, we are writing to express our concerns about the recommendations tabled by the Sign By-law Unit, which are being discussed as Item EX21.8 at City Council on January 31, 2017.

The concerns we have for this proposal are threefold:

- We are concerned the proposed signage will have a negative impact on the sightlines of the existing signage surrounding Yonge-Dundas Square.
- We are concerned the third-party programing of advertising around Yonge-Dundas Square will detract from the community programmed screens. We would also like clarity on how the community programing will be managed.
- 3. We are also concerned with the weight and overall structural stability of the new additions.

We urge council members to direct staff to re-evaluate the report and address these concerns before the motion is considered.
