Dear Mayor Tory and Councillors,

On behalf of my board of directors I wish to report The Friends of Fort York & Garrison Common wholeheartedly support the recommendations of Toronto & East York Community Council, meeting April 4, to rezone the lands at 28 Bathurst Street, (Ward 19) as 'OR' (Open Space) and 'G' (park). Our reasons are as follows:

## Need

As the populations of the Fort York, King-Spadina and Niagara Neighbourhoods have swollen beyond original expectations during the last twenty years, a serious need for more open space has emerged from the high density model adopted for development throughout this area.

## Cost

The cost of acquiring land for parks in the vicinity of 28 Bathurst is extremely high given its alternate uses. The circumstances that saw the City of Toronto acquire and hold the land at 28 Bathurst for thirty years now work in favour of creating new open space for little more than the expense of remediating the ground for park use and reimbursing Build Toronto for its sunk planning costs.

## **Timeliness**

The availability of 28 Bathurst for immediate development as a park fits with the emerging necklace of open spaces around Fort York (see plan attached) as the City tries to keep up with the pace of nearby residential development, and relieves the pressure of need sooner than complementary initiatives like Rail Deck Park.
