The technical amendments are important as it allows the Bill (draft zoning by-law) to be adopted by Council at this session allowing all matters to be consolidated at the OMB given the likelihood of appeals. This was a formal request by the applicant's solicitor and after a series of recent meetings, determined to be agreeable to City Legal and supportive of the City legal strategy for defence of the Steeles Regeneration Study adopted by Council through OPA 321. A Pre-Hearing is scheduled on May 16th. It also revises the S. 37 Park improvement allocation to another park per Councillor Karygiannis' instructions given recent information from Parks and Recreation Services. Other technical amendments better reflect the proposed plans which were before PGM and Council for consideration.

Confirmation by all parties on the approach and confirmation of technical details, required these matters to be addressed in a Supplementary Report, which is just being made available to Council. As soon as the supplementary report is properly put in front of Council by Clerks, I will advise and I understand that Councillor Karygiannis is supportive of re-opening only for this purpose.
