Our association represents approximately 900 homes in the East York community and we're hoping that you will allow the East York logo to appear on the street name signs. This is a very important issue for our community because the logo honours our heritage as East Yorkers.

The East York logo is a cherished symbol in our community and it's already very visible on many of the street signs that exist today as well as the East York Civic Centre and other places of interest. Sadly, in recent years, we have seen a decline in the use of the logo of the former Borough of East York.

As we continue to grow as a city and welcome many new residents, we feel it's important for all Torontonians to be reminded on the location of East York within the larger city.
