PUBLIC NOTICE

Amendments to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures, respecting Proposed Amendment to the Rules of Council and Committee Debate

At its meeting in Committee Room 1, 2nd Floor, Toronto City Hall, 100 Queen Street West, Toronto, on Wednesday April 19, 2017, the Executive Committee will consider Item EX24.28, which contains the following recommendations which may result in amendments to City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 27, Council Procedures:

"That City Council amend the Council Procedures to provide that:

1. Members be permitted to question City officials as well as the mover immediately after other members have made amending motions during committee and Council debate.
2. Such questions and their responses be limited to 5 minutes per member.
3. Such questions be limited to seeking information about the effect of the preceding amendment."

It is proposed that the by-law(s) be adopted at the Council meeting to be held on April 26, 2017 or at a subsequent meeting.

The City will also make your communication and any personal information in it – such as your postal address, telephone number or e-mail address – available to the public.

Many Committee, Board, and Advisory Body meetings are broadcast live over the internet for the public to view. If you speak at the meeting you will appear in the video broadcast. Video broadcasts are archived and continue to be publicly available.

Closed Meeting Requirements: If the Committee wants to meet in closed session (privately), a Committee member must make a motion to do so and give the reason why the Committee has to meet privately (City of Toronto Act, 2006).
