Full text of the e-mail campaign message:

Dear Mayor Tory and the Executive Committee,

This is in relation to item EX27.24 and the Liberty Village Pedestrian bridge. As I'm sure you are well aware, Liberty Village and its surrounding neighbourhoods are home to more than 30 000 Torontonians and more than 10 000 employees. This neighbourhood has been promised a pedestrian bridge for the last 8 years and it is desperately needed as, geographically, we are hemmed in and getting into and out of LV is difficult. 71% of us walk, cycle and take transit to work and having an access point midway through the village up to and down from King St. West is a critical part of our infrastructure as we will also be growing with another 8 condominiums joining us in the next 5 years. With over 10 000 condo units over 8 square blocks contributing more than \$40 000 000 in property taxes each year AND millions in development charges having already been collected - with more to come - we feel the expense is justified to continue to build out our thriving neighbourhood. While we understand that an efficient use of city funds is always critical, we believe that this bridge is worth the expense and strongly encourage you to support this cost increase.
