The Section 37 funds are being used for the intended purpose and have been secured.

The Total Project Costs for the SOGR and Upgrade work at the High Park Zoo is \$250,000. The Friends of High Park will fund \$50,000 from their fundraising activities and the City will contribute \$200,000 from the same capital project titled "2017 CAMP (SGR) Special Facilities Buildings Structures" funded by: \$150,000 from the above noted Section 37 funding and \$50,000 from Capital from Current from the existing 2017 Council Approved Capital Budget.

There are no anticipated additional operating impacts as a result of this upgrade.
