Subject: Parking Restrictions on Almore Avenue


SUMMARY:

My office has been contacted by residents on Almore Avenue as well as by the school administration with concern that during the morning and afternoon drop off/pick up, parents are parking on both sides of the roadway and obstruction traffic flow. Currently, parking is permitted for a maximum of 3 hours on the north and south side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and Yeomans Road (to the east). The recommendations below would alleviate the concerns.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. That North York Community Council direct Transportation Services to
 - Install 15 min Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday' on the south side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and a point 78 metres east
 - Install no stopping, 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 6 p.m., Monday to Friday', on the north side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and Granite Street
