Subject: Parking Regulations: Almore Avenue

Councillor Pasternak,

Transportation Services, North York District was requested by your office on behalf of the administration of Bnei Askiva School to review the feasibility of amending the parking regulations on Almore Avenue, in front of the school located at 159 Almore Avenue.

The school administration is concerned that during the morning and afternoon drop off/pick up, parents are parking on both sides of the roadway and obstructing traffic flow.

Almore Avenue is a local roadway with a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h. There are municipal sidewalks on the south side of the road and the pavement width is approximately 8.5 metres. Currently, Parking is permitted for a maximum of 3 hours on the north and south side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and Yeomans Road.

An on-site assessment has confirmed that Almore Avenue is reduced to one lane when cars park on both sides. Motorists have also been observed to be double parking, thus affecting the flow of two-way traffic.

Based on our review we recommends:

- Install 15 min Parking, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday' on the south side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and a point 78 metres east
- Install no stopping, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday', on the north side of Almore Avenue between Faywood Boulevard and Granite Street.

The above recommendation will accommodate for a drop-off / pick-up area, encourage vehicle turnover and improve the flow of two-way traffic. Prior to bringing forward a report to NYCC to amend the parking regulations, we are requesting your concurrence.
