

## **On-Street Accessible Parking Space - Castlefield Avenue**

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting North York Community Council to authorize the installation of an on-street accessible parking space on the south side of Castlefield Avenue fronting 239 Castlefield Avenue.

The installation of an on-street accessible parking space will address the needs of a local resident, while reducing the available on-street parking by one space.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Acting Director, Transportation Services, North York District recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Designate an on-street accessible parking space on the south side of Castlefield Avenue, from a point 143 metres east Avenue Road to a point 5.5 metres further east.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

All costs associated with amendments to the parking regulations on Castlefield Avenue are included within the Transportation Services 2017 Operating Budget estimates.

## DECISION HISTORY

---

This report addresses a new initiative.

## COMMENTS

---

Transportation Services was requested by a resident of Castlefield Avenue to investigate the feasibility of installing an on-street accessible parking space on the south side of Castlefield Avenue, fronting 239.

Castlefield Avenue is an 8.5 metre wide two-way local road with sidewalks on both sides of the road.

The traffic regulations on Castlefield Avenue are as follows:

- No parking, anytime, on the north side of Castlefield Avenue from a point 36.5 metres east of Avenue Road to Yonge Street.
- Parking is permitted for a maximum of 15 minutes on the north side of Castlefield Avenue from a point 15 metres east of Avenue to a point 21.5 metres further east.
- No stopping on the south side of Castlefield Avenue from Avenue Road to a point 36.5 metres east.
- Overnight Parking is allowed on the south side of Castlefield Avenue for Permit Holders.

There are a total of 34 on-street parking spaces available on Castlefield Avenue between Avenue Road and Rosewell Avenue, and currently 22 parking permits have been issued to residents for this section of roadway.

The applicant is a holder of a valid "Accessible Parking Permit" issued by the Ministry of Transportation of Ontario.

The requested location of the on-street accessible parking space would be on the south side of Castlefield Avenue located 143 metres east of Avenue Road to a point 5.5 metres further east.

The installation of an on-street accessible parking space will not have a negative impact on the flow of traffic on Castlefield Avenue.

In view of the above, Transportation Services supports the installation of the designated on-street accessible parking space.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
