

## **Parking Prohibition – Agate Road**

**To:** North York Community Council

### **SUMMARY**

---

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to prohibit parking at all times on the west side of Agate Road, 2.5 metres north and south of the driveway entrances to 1154 Wilson Avenue.

The proposed parking prohibition will address concerns with access and egress to the property of 1154 Wilson Avenue.

### **RECOMMENDATIONS**

---

The Acting Director, Transportation Services, North York District recommends that North York Community Council:

1. Prohibit parking at all times on the west side of Agate Road, between Wilson Avenue and a point approximately 45 metres further north.
2. Prohibit parking at all times on the west side of Agate Road, between a point approximately 89 metres north of Wilson Avenue and a point approximately 14 metres further north.

### **FINANCIAL IMPACT**

---

All costs associated with the installation of parking prohibitions on Agate Road are included within the Transportation Services 2017 Operating Budget.

### **DECISION HISTORY**

---

This report addresses a new initiative.

## **COMMENTS**

---

Transportation Services was requested by area residents to investigate the feasibility of prohibiting parking adjacent the driveway entrances to 1154 Wilson Avenue.

Agate Road is a two-way north/south local roadway with a regulatory speed limit of 50 km/h. Municipal sidewalks are located on both sides of the street and the pavement width is approximately 8.5 metres.

Currently, parking is allowed for up to three hours on the west side of Agate Road between Wilson Avenue and Victory Drive. Parking is prohibited at all times on the east side of Agate Road between Wilson Avenue and Victory Drive.

Residents have expressed concerns of vehicles often parked too close to the driveway entrances obstructing sightlines and restricting access and egress.

The proposed parking prohibition will improve sight lines and access for motorists entering and exiting the property. A total of 2 parking spaces will be lost due to the parking prohibitions.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
