**RE: Water Flow and Quality from 18 Graydon Hall Drive**

The City of Toronto has been in discussions with Tridel, the owner and developer of the property at 18 Graydon Hall Drive, over encroachment rights to allow the running of pipes from an underground aquifer below the existing condo tower, into the Don River. There have been questions regarding the flow levels and quality of the water being removed from the ground into the river.

**RECOMMENDATIONS:**

That North York Community Council:

1. Direct the appropriate City Officials to submit a report to the North York Community Council meeting on September 6, 2017 on:
  - a. the water discharge being released into the Don River;
  - b. the quality of the water being released into the Don River; and
  - c. the impacts of what will happen when the Ministry of the Environment (MOE) discharge permit which is allowing the discharge of this water into the Don River, expires.
