

Parking Prohibition - Ianhall Road

SUMMARY

This staff report is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

Transportation Services is requesting approval to prohibit parking from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday on the east side of Ianhall Road.

The parking prohibition will address concerns of the residents with regards to the roadway being used for daily parking by the employees of the government offices on Wilson Avenue and the daily drop off and pick up activity associated with St. Raphael School.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Director, Transportation Services, North York District recommends that:

1. North York Community Council prohibit parking from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday on the east side of Ianhall Road, from Victory Drive to a point 76 metres north.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

All costs associated with amendments to the parking regulations on Ianhall Road are included within the Transportation Services 2017 Interim Operating Budget.

DECISION HISTORY

This report addresses a new initiative.

COMMENTS

Transportation Services was requested by Councillor Maria Augimeri, on behalf of local residents, to review the feasibility of prohibiting weekday daytime parking on the east side of Ianhall Road. The residents that are affected by the implementation of the weekday daytime parking prohibition have submitted a petition to the Ward Councillor in support of the requested parking amendment.

Ianhall Road is a local roadway with a regulatory speed limit of 40 km/h from Wintergreen Road to Gade Drive. Municipal sidewalks are located on both sides of the roadway and the pavement width is approximately 8.5 metres. The roadway is primarily comprised of residential dwellings, with the exception of St. Raphael Separate School, located at the north end of this section of roadway.

Currently, parking is permitted for a maximum of three hours on the east side of Ianhall Road from Victory Drive to the north limit of 23 Ianhall Road. Stopping is prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday on the west and north side of the roadway.

Our observations have confirmed that the school drop off activity does impede access to the residential driveways on this section of roadway. Although the petition states that long term parking is occurring, no long term parking was observed by staff.

The implementation of the parking prohibition from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday from Victory Drive to a point 76 metres north, which will encompass 15, 17, 19, 21 and 23 Ianhall Road, should address the resident's concerns.

Given that the existing stopping regulations in the area are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday, parking should be prohibited from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday to Friday on Ianhall Road from Victory Drive to a point 76 metres north. The proposed parking times will then be in keeping with the existing regulations on this roadway.

The Ward Councillor is aware of the recommendations of this staff report.
