Subject: No Stopping Regulation on Leacrest Road

Summary:

There have been concerns with parked cars on the north side of Leacrest Road blocking driveways. The issue seems to be with a small parking zone due to an intersection on one side and fire hydrant on the other side. Cars are trying to squeeze into the parking zone leading to driveways getting blocked.

Therefore, I am requesting to implement a 'No Stopping' sign anytime on the north side of Leacrest Road between Rolph Road and a point 32 metres east. This will also clarify the no parking zone where the fire hydrant is.

Transportation Services has been consulted and they did not raise any concerns with the proposed prohibition of stopping in this section.

Recommendation:

1. North York Community Council to prohibit stopping on the north side of Leacrest Road, between Rolph Road and a point 32 metres east.
