Subject: Katherine Road Parking Prohibitions

SUMMARY:

This motion is about a matter for which Community Council has delegated authority from City Council to make a final decision, provided that it is not amended so that it varies with City policy or by-laws.

The Principal of Ancaster Public School has requested that a student pickup and drop off zone be implemented along the north side of Katherine Road. The Principal cited student safety concerns as the primary reason for implementing these new parking prohibitions. After consulting with Toronto Parking Enforcement, Transportation Services Division and Ancaster Public School, the community was surveyed to determine support for the proposed changes. Over a two week period, residents informed my office of their preference, and the majority of respondents voiced their support for the recommended changes.

RECOMMENDATIONS

That North York Community Council;

1. Rescind the no stopping 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday regulation on the north side of Katherine Road, between Garratt Boulevard and Ancaster Road.
2. Rescind the school bus loading zone from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., on the north side of Katherine Road, from a point 29 metres west of Ancaster Road and a point 61 metres west thereof.
3. Permit 15 minute parking from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the north side of Katherine Road between Ancaster Road and Garratt Boulevard.
4. Prohibit stopping from 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday to Friday on the south side of Katherine Road between Ancaster Road to Garratt Boulevard.
5. That North York Community Council direct Transportation Services to take all necessary actions to implement the above.
