SUMMARY

This report will recommend that City Council approve the proposed alterations to the heritage properties at 738, 740, 742, 744, and 746 Bathurst Street, 585 Bloor Street West and 581, 583, 585, 587, 589, 591, 593, 595, 597, 588, 590, 592, 594, 596, 598, 600 and 602 Markham Street; approve the removal of the heritage building at 610 Markham Street and its relocation to 604-606 Markham Street and subsequent alterations upon relocation; state its intention to designate 738, 740, 742, 744 and 746 Bathurst Street, 585 Bloor Street West and 581, 583, 585, 587, 589, 591, 593, 595, 597, 588, 590, 592, 594, 596, 598, 600, 602, 604-606 and 610 Markham Street under Part IV, Section 29 of the Ontario Heritage Act, and give authority to enter into Heritage Easement Agreements for all of these properties with the property owner.

This report will be made available prior to the Toronto Preservation Board Meeting scheduled for March 23, 2017.
