

Naming of a Proposed Private Street at 1251 Bridletowne Circle

SUMMARY

This report recommends that the name "Eaton Park Lane" be approved to identify a proposed private street at 1251 Bridletowne Circle.

Community Councils have delegated authority to decide street naming matters which comply with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Engineering and Construction Services recommends that Scarborough Community Council:

1. Approve the name "Eaton Park Lane" for the proposed private street at 1251 Bridletowne Circle.
2. Request the applicant to pay the costs, estimated to be \$500.00, for the fabrication and installation of the street name signage; and
3. Request the owner and successors of the subject lands to maintain, at their own risk, the street name signage installed under Recommendation 2 of the report (September 28, 2017) from the Director, Engineering Support Services, Engineering and Construction Services.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

There are no financial implications to the City resulting from the adoption of this report. The estimated cost of \$500.00 for the street name signage is to be paid by the applicant.

DECISION HISTORY

This is the first time that this issue is before Community Council.

COMMENTS

On August 24, 2017 an application was received from Barry Waltman of Genesis Homes, to name the proposed private street to be located at 1251 Bridletowne Circle, "Eaton Park" in recognition of the fact that the property was, for 40 years, the site of a former secondary school by the name of Timothy Eaton Business and Technical Institute.

The proposed name has been circulated for comment and is acceptable to Toronto Police Service, Toronto Fire Services, Toronto Paramedic Services and Councillor Kelly.

The lane is shown as PART 1 on Attachment No.1 Sketch No. PS-2017-084.

This naming proposal complies with the City of Toronto Street Naming Policy.

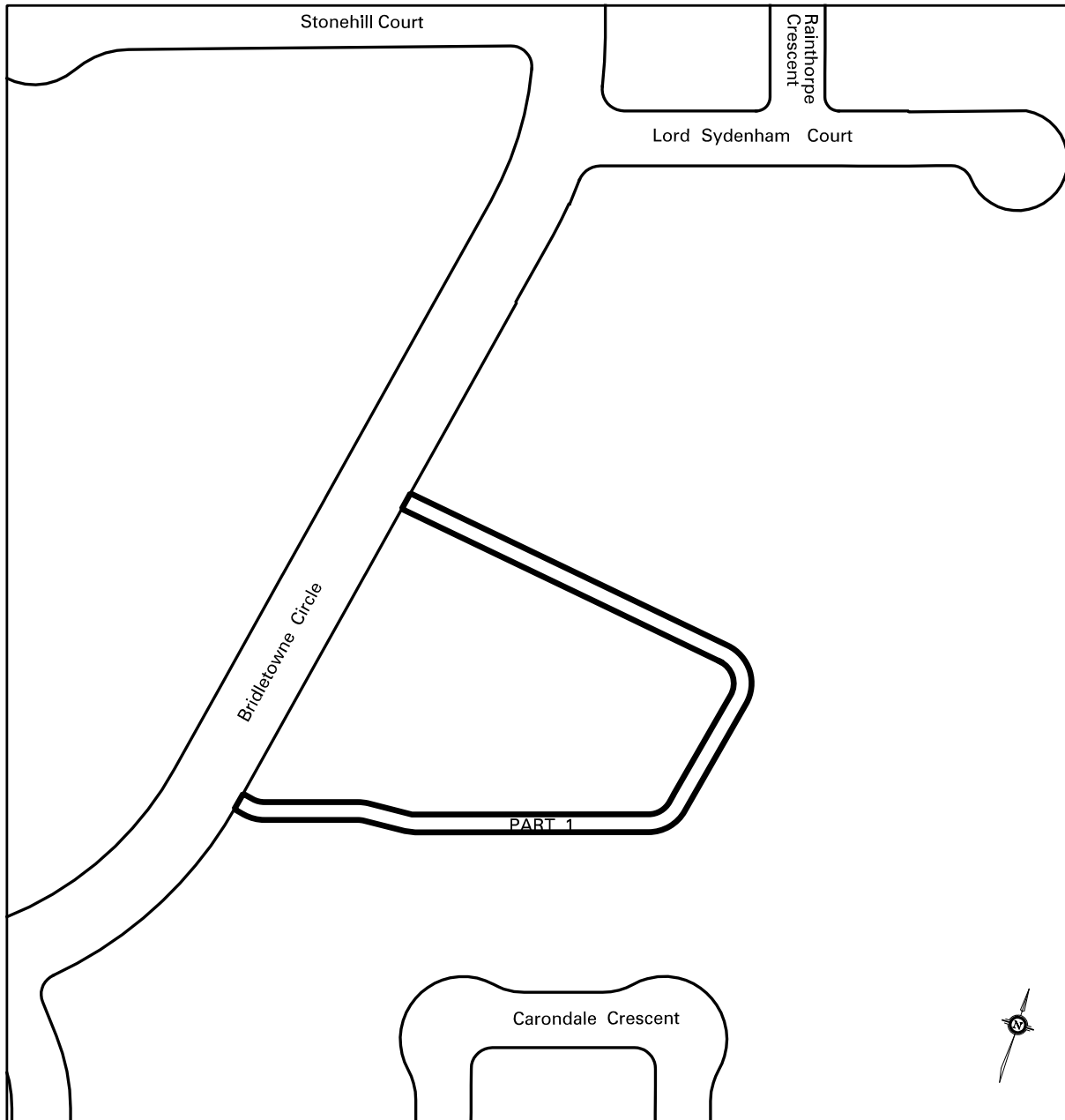
