SUMMARY

As the Toronto Transit Commission (TTC) operates a transit service on the subject streets, City Council approval of this report is required.

Transportation Services and the Toronto Parking Authority are requesting City Council approval for the installation of on-street paid parking at various locations in Ward 19, Ward 20 and Ward 28.

Transportation Services and Toronto Parking Authority staff reviewed converting locations of existing free parking or no parking, to paid on-street parking, based on parking areas of high demand that are functionally safe, appropriate, and economically viable. While this report seeks City Council approval for the installation of on-street paid parking in various high demand locations in Wards 19, 20 and 28, this is an ongoing initiative, and Transportation Services and Toronto Parking Authority staff continue to review and report on potential new on-street paid parking opportunities throughout the City of Toronto.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Acting Director, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District, and the President, Toronto Parking Authority recommend that:

1. City Council authorize the amendments to parking regulations required to establish new on-street paid parking locations, as set out in Attachments 2 and 3, to the report dated May 25, 2017 from the Acting Director, Transportation Services, Toronto and East York District, and the President, Toronto Parking Authority. All cost associated with the necessary signage changes are included within the Transportation Services 2017 Operating Budget. All costs associated with the installation of parking machines will be assumed by the Toronto Parking Authority. These recommendations, if fully implemented, are projected to generate an increase in annual revenue of up to \$780,000 from the on-street paid parking program.

DECISION HISTORY

Toronto City Council at its meeting of December 9, 2015, adopted Item EX10.25 entitled "2016 Rate Supported Budgets - Toronto Parking Authority" and, in so doing, directed the General Manager, Transportation Services, in consultation with the President, Toronto Parking Authority, "to actively identify and take the necessary steps to implement new on-street paid parking opportunities where functionally safe and appropriate, and economically viable (for example locations where parking is not currently permitted, or free on-street parking is in effect) to supplement lost parking revenues and to improve service to local businesses by creating more short stay parking spaces in areas of need, and to report on the progress of this initiative to the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee by Fall 2016, prior to the 2017 Budget process."

COMMENTS

Establishing on-street paid parking and its inherent hourly rates and hours of operation parameters is critical in appropriately managing the equitable distribution of valuable curbside space. On-street parking spaces are typically the most convenient in serving areas of high demand, including local business areas. The on-street parking supply is meant to serve a short-stay need (considered less than 3 hours), thus relying on higher turnover. It is not meant to accommodate longer stay commuter-type travel. Accordingly, implementing hourly rates and hours of operation for on-street parking spaces in response to emerging demand trends are key tools in fairly allocating this scarce resource, by encouraging turnover of the on-street parking supply, so it is available to as many patrons as possible.

Transportation Services and Toronto Parking Authority Staff have reviewed the parking regulations on streets in the following areas and have identified that the locations identified would benefit from the introduction of on-street paid parking to better serve area demands and accommodate the maximum number of users.

Currently, the various locations listed below have regulations that either allow for the 3 hour maximum parking (unsigned), restricted 1-hour parking, or do not permit parking.

Ward 19 - Trinity-Spadina

- East Liberty Street, north side, between Pirandello Street and Western Battery Road;
- Shaw Street, both sides, between Shank Street and Queen Street West;

Ward 20 - Trinity-Spadina

• McCaul Street, east side, between Orde Street and College Street

Ward 28 - Toronto Centre-Rosedale

• York Street, east side, between King Street West and Richmond Street West

The proposed amendments will result in approximately 124 new on-street paid parking spaces.

The Councillors for Ward 19, Ward 20 and Ward 28, have been consulted and advised of the Recommendation contained in this staff report.






