The *Copper Kettle for Music Therapy* events are free to the public, social events aimed to get anyone and everyone together to listen to live music, play yard style games, and enjoy some great food and drinks. The purpose of gathering everyone together is to bring awareness to The Canadian Music Therapy Trust Fund.

Copper Kettle West for Music Therapy will take place on June 1st from 3pm - 10pm at Liberty Market Galleria in Liberty Village. *Copper Kettle Central for Music Therapy* will take place on June 8th from 3pm - 10pm on Lombard St. (street closure) between Victoria St. and Barbed Wire Lane. The last event, *Copper Kettle North for Music Therapy* will take place on St Joseph St. (street closure) between Bay St. and Queen's Park Cres E on Saturday June 10th from 11pm - 6pm. In addition to bringing more attention to the charity, the *Copper Kettle For Music Therapy Event Series* will bring more people and memorable experiences to these areas of the city.

In order to assure that this event runs smoothly and efficiently for all involved, The Canadian Music Therapy Trust Fund, working with Drink Inc. Events, are diligent in taking all steps necessary in order to provide a safe environment for guests and vendors. Our Management Team is supported by experienced and well-trained event staff.
